SCHEME FOR NATIONAL AWARDS - 2010 RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT EFFORTS IN MICRO, SMALLAND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (MSMEs)

1. OBJECTIVE

The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in India have undergone a vast development in the last five decades. The MSMEs have registered tremendous growth as also the progress in terms of quality production, exports, innovation, product development and import substitution, very much beyond the expected objectives of setting up MSMEs by the planners of industrial production base in the country. Entrepreneurial efforts have made it possible to produce number of items, which hitherto were imported. In quite a few cases new variants so produced are having additional attributes than their original versions and are capable of solving a multitude of user problems.

This all has become possible to encourage such in-house R&D efforts and promote this spirit in larger interest of qualitative development of MSMEs with a view to recognise their effort and contribution.

2. AWARDS

The Awards will be of following categories, details of which are as under.

1. National Award for Research & Development Efforts in Micro & Small Enterprises:

- (1) First National Award Rs. 1,00,000/- Cash Prize, a Certificate and a Trophy.
- (2) Second National Award Rs. 75,000/- Cash Prize, a Certificate and a Trophy.

2. National Award for Research & Development Efforts in Medium Enterprises:

- (1) First National Award Rs. 1,00,000/- Cash Prize, a Certificate and a Trophy.
- (2) Second National Award Rs. 75,000/- Cash Prize, a Certificate and a Trophy.

3. Special Recognition Award

MSMEs scoring marks above 80 percent and (50 percent in case of North Eastern Region including Sikkim) will be given Cash prize of Rs. 20,000/- each, a Certificate and a Trophy.

3. PERIODICITY & ELIGIBILITY

The Awards will be given for every calendar year to deserving entrepreneurs managing Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises have permantent SSI registration/have filed Entrepreneurs Memorandum part-II with the authorities notified by respective State Governments/UT Administration in accordance with the provisions contained in the Micro,

Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act. 2006, which has since come into force from 2 October 2006. The MSMEs should have been in continuous production during last three years ie. 2007-08, 2008-09 & 2009-10.

4. CRITERIA

The evaluation for Award is to be done on the basis of and on the Criteria & Proforma for Evaluation and Awarding Marks (Form Z) specifically designed for the purpose. The critical areas include:

- (i) Nature of R&D achievement.
- (ii) Infrastructure evolved for in-house R&D effort.
- (iii) Economic potential of the R&D project realized/expected in terms of resource utilization, import substitution, export, energy conservation, environmental protection, cost reduction and other advantages.
- (iv) Status of commercialization project developed.
- (v) Detail of patents/design copyright obtained or applied for.
- (vi) Societal impact/contribution.
- (vii) Growth trends of the MSMEs.
- (viii) No. of persons (Technical & Scientific) engaged in R&D activities and their qualification.
- (ix) Leadership Abilities.
- (x) Strategic Intiatives.

5.1 State Level Selection Committee after proper screening is to select eligible MSMEs in order of merit including at least one each from SC/ST and a woman entrepreneur for the consideration of the National Level Selection

Committee. Recommendations made by the State/UT Level Selection Committee that do not conform to the above stipulation will not be considered. MSMEs should be assessed based on the data/information submitted by the entrepreneur after verification.

- 5.2 For the purpose of evaluation by the State/UT Level Selection Committee, the Evaluation Criteria for awarding marks (Form Z) is enclosed. The recommendations of the State/UT Level Selection Committee should also accompany the break-up of marks on Form Z (duly completed).
- 5.3 Minimum qualifying marks as per criteria for consideration by the National Level Selection Committee for any type of Award will be 60 percent and 50 percent in case of enterprise from SC/ST and NER including Sikkim There will be no bar for an Awardee to be nominated or considered for a higher Award in the subsequent year. The Awardees should not be nominated or considered for the same or lower Award in the subsequent 5 year(s).
- 5.4 State/UT Level Selection Committee while recommending the names for National Awards would institute such inquiries as may be necessary to satisfy themselves that the entrepreneur has been abiding by all statutory requirements in vogue, is maintaining the proper documentation and is also not involved in any economic/other offence for which enquiry/legal action is pending. The MSME status of the enterprise for the Award year be specifically verified and certified keeping in view the investment limit permissible in plant & Machinery as also other norms in vogue and in accordance with the provisions contained in the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act. 2006, which has since come into force from 2 October 2006.
- 5.5 A Committee consisting of the Representative(s) of Director, MSME-DI and a Representative (s) of Directorate of Industries of the State/UT (on behalf of the State/UT Selection Committee) may visit the MSME to verify the information furnished in the application form including details on technology, performance, quality, Enterprises status, growth rate etc. and prepare a report for consideration of State Level Selection Committee while finalizing its recommendations.
- 5.6 The State Level Selection Committee may send its recommendations along with the applications to the Office of the Development Commissioner (MSME), Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India, 7th Floor, 'A' Wing, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi-110108 latest by **2nd June, 2011.**

6. COMPOSITION OF NATIONAL LEVEL SELECTION COMMITTEE (NLSC)

The National Level Selection Committee will consist of —

(i) Additional Secretary & Development Commissioner, Chairman (MSME) Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India.

(ii) Two Secretaries, Department of Industries of State Govt. Member to be nominated by Govt. of India.

(iii) Director General, National Productivity Council or his nominee Member

(iv) Director General, Council of Scientific & Industrial Research Member (CSIR) or his nominee

(v) Nominee of the Secretary, Department of Science & Member Technology (DST) (vi) Managing Director, National Research Development Member Corporation (NRDC), or his nominee Dean, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) New Delhi. or his nominee Member (vii) Member Managing Director, Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI). or his nominee (ix) President, Laghu Udyog Bharti Member (x) President, Federation of Associations of Small Industries Member of India (FASII) Additional Development Commissioner O/o DC (MSME) (xi) Member Convenor

7. METHODOLOGY

For purposes of selecting enterprises for consideration for awards, the following procedure will be observed:-

- (i) The eligible Enterprises will send their nominations in the prescribed proforma in duplicate (with original/downloded only on the prescibed form) to Director, MSME-DI of the State where their MSMEs is registered/have filed Entrepreneurs Memorandum (EM).
- (ii) State Level Selection Committee will select MSME for the Award- 2010 and award marks on the Criteria proforma (**Form Z**) enclosed.
- (iii) The recommendations of the State Level Selection Committee(SLSC) received without break-up of marks on Form Z and those on Application form will not be considered by the National Level Selection Committee (NLSC).
- (iv) The applications will further be scrutinized by the technical group of the office of DC(MSME) for evaluating the mark for submitting before National Level Selection Committee for selecting the awardees.
- (v) Qualifying marks as per criteria for consideration by the National Level Selection Committee will be 60% and (50% in case of NER including Sikkim).

8. PRIVILEGES

The Award winners are given second AC sleeper Class, Railway fare for to and fro journeys performed by them by the shortest route from the location of the unit and daily allowance as per govt. rules to attend the Award Function. The winners of the Award shall have the privilege of using the symbol of the Award in their letter heads and their employees can wear labels, pins, ties or other distinctive badges with Award symbol indicating the year of the Award. The amount of Cash Prize received by the Winners of the National Award is exempted under Section 10(17) of Income Tax Act 1961.

9. TO WHOM TO APPLY

The eligible Enterprises will send their nominations in the prescribed proforma in duplicate to Director, MSME-DI of the State where their MSME is registered/have filed Entrepreneurs Memorandum. The application could also be routed to Director, MSME-DI through Director of Industries of State/General Manager, District Industries Centre but it should reach the Director MSME-DI by the last date submission of application **ie 2nd May, 2011.** (Visit Website:- www.dcmsme.gov.in)

Dear Entrepreneur,

Kindly ensure that while filling the form following instructions are strictly adhered to.

- 1. Application forms are provided free of cost. However, while submitting the application, applicant must ensure that they enclose a demand draft of Rs. 250/- or Rs. 125/- (as the case may be) payable at New Delhi in favour of 'Pay & Accounts Officer (MSME)'. Write on the back of DD your enterprise's. name, station and scheme of Award under which claim has been applied. Enclose a photocopy of Demand Draft with the application form.
- 2. Write on the back of extra photographs, your name in Block Capital.
- 3. The application should be accompanied with the printed brochures, technical literature of the product and a write-up on the product(s) and the enterprise. Answers to the different columns of the application form should be specific and non-evasive. It is compulsory to enclose appropriate documentary evidences in support of the claims made.
- 4. Type/print in capital letters, your name, the name and address of the small scale enterprise (both in Hindi & English) set up by you against which the award is being claimed. Give all the details of District/Taluka, State, and Pin Code etc.
- 5. In case you belong to SC/ST category, please ensure to attach documentary proof, duly attested, failing which the benefits on that account may not be given.
- 6. Enclose attested photo copy of the permanent SSI registration/Entrepreneurial Memorumdum (EM) part-II issued by District Industries centre/competent Authority.
- 7. Please specify product(s) manufactured or services rendered. (Ref. Col. 10)
- 8. Please type/print the required figures for production, profits, etc. in rupees lakhs only. Ensure to provide original investment in rupees lakhs in plant and machinery. (Do not take depreciated value). In case, decimal points are to be used they should be clearly visible. Do not include investment in land, building, consumables, jigs/fixtures, moulds/dies pollution control equipment and captive power generation sets, while providing figures of investment in plant and machinery. (Ref. Col. 12). Please also enclose Affidavits Annexure 8 & 9.
- 9. Entries under column 14 to 19 of the form should be made in such a manner as to specifically indicate the step by step evolution of Research & Development Efforts which is to be distinctly different from normal production

process, and ensure that in-house R&D efforts get vividly exhibited, their impact become visible for being considered suitable for award.

- 10. Under Col. 14 while mentioning details of R&D work it should be specified whether the development resulted changes in attributes of the product, uses of the product and the design of the product or it involved modification in the manufacturing process or in case of servicing units whether any innovative servicing techniques useful for the user have become possible by virtue of the R&D.
- 11. Under Col. 14 existing products/services as per the available technologies should first be specified. Effort should be made to outline the names/brands of competing products/processes/services, the names of the customers, a brief write-up on need and objectives of R&D work should be specified as also the comparison of advantages achieved by virtue of the development work undertaken by the unit for which the details have been mentioned in the column.
- 12. Col. 15, 16 & 17 are self-explanatory. Under Col. 18 which exhibits the relevance of the R&D work in terms of utilisation of technology, raw material, machinery, under the resources and import substitutions, energy conservation, environmental protection or any other advantage which have become possible by the development work undertaken need be clearly specified/presented with details and supporting documents etc.
- 13. Under Col. 19 it is intended to note the commercial advantages achieved by virtue of R&D work undertaken and the specific details for the same be given.
- 14. It is to be emphasized that R&D efforts are additional achievements aimed at strengthening the present structure/ performance in terms of product/production process/techniques. The initial achievements of product/process development while setting up of the unit are not to be included for eligibility as research input intended to be awarded under this scheme.
- 15. Each & every document should be properly tagged and given page number.

Note: In order to ensure proper evaluation, appropriate annexures be prepared to substantiate and support the claims made in different columns. In house R&D and evolution of research effort should get established systematically through entries in different columns.
